2009 Price List & AWO Hunt Recommendations

NEW FOR '09! THE DEADLINE TO APPLY FOR DEER AND SHEEP IS JUNE 9, 2009!

NOTE: THERE ARE NO INTERNET APPLICATIONS FOR THESE TAGS! YOU MUST DOWNLOAD THE FORMS OFF THE G&F WEBSITE, WWW.AZGFD.COM AND SEND IN THE APPROPRIATE FEES. YOU MUST HAVE A 2009 ARIZONA HUNTING LICENSE TO APPLY OR YOU MUST APPLY FOR A LICENSE AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. 2009 NR HUNTING LICENSE IS \$151.25.

SPECIAL NOTE! If you do not have maximum points for deer, then in all reality you cannot draw a tag for the premium (P) deer units in northern Arizona. This is due to the 10% limitation on non-residents and the application of the 20% pass draw, which is held before the regular draw. In that draw, those with maximum bonus points are in a draw for 20% of the available tags per hunt number. In 2008, every non-resident deer hunter who had a tag for a premium deer hunt north of the Colorado River (exceptions 12A West Early/12A East Early) had maximum bonus points! There are just over 260 non-residents who have maximum bonus points and 60 residents. The maximum bonus points going into this year's draw is 12. My advice is to look hard at the early westside Kaibab hunt (Hunt #1014) this year if you're not close to max points. You can expect to see bucks in the 18-24 inch range on this hunt, with an occasional larger buck. 750 tags available!

These recommendations are for those only with max. bonus points. Otherwise, apply for bonus point only (Hunt # 1000, \$7.50) and save the \$232.75 that is charged if you apply for a tag.

MULE DEER (rifle)(P):

1st choice: Hunt #1021, Unit 13B AZ Strip Nov 6-15 2009 55 tags \$4,500 Some huge deer taken every year on this hunt, but big mulies not behind every tree. This price includes a week of pre-season right before the hunt plus the full 10 days to give you the maximum opportunity to take a true buck of a lifetime! We've been hunting on the Strip for over 20 years!

2nd choice: Hunt # 1015, Unit 12A West Late Nov. 20 Nov. 29 2009 175 tags \$4,500 Hunt is in the rut! Last year Dr. Alan Gay took a great buck on this hunt and we saw four larger than his! We hunt for the full 10 days to give you the maximum opportunity to take a once-in-a-lifetime buck!! We've successfully hunted the Kaibab since 1972!

For those with less than max. deer bonus points, we recommend these hunts.

1st Choice: Hunt 1014 Unit 12A West (early) Oct. 30-Nov. 8 2009 750 tags. \$3,500

Most of the bucks you'll see are 18-24 inches wide. Some bigger bucks up to 30 inches are taken on this hunt. We'll hunt for the full 10 days if needed to get you a good buck!
2nd Choice: Hunt 1173 Units 39,40A, 40B, 41, 42 Dec. 11-31 2009 50 tags. \$4,000 This is a 5 day MUZZLELOADER desert deer hunt with the best desert mule deer guides in the state! Bucks up to 28 inches have been taken in the past on this hunt.

MULE DEER (archery)(P)

1st choice: Hunt 1180 13B Aug. 21-Sept 10 2009 30 tags \$4,500 10 days. Super hunt for those who are willing to hold out for a boomer! Last year one of our hunters missed a 190+ 4 X 4 at 30, 30, and 40 yards! He "ended up" taking a 28 inch 6 X 5 that scored 183+. Out other hunter missed two non-typicals that were over 190! NR must have max bonus points. Residents can draw this tag with just a few bonus points.

JUNIORS-ONLY DEER HUNTS: Note NR Juniors-only deer tags are just \$32.50!

1st choice: hunt 1174, Unit 16A, Dec. 18-31 2009 30 tags \$1,500 Rut hunt with a muzzleloader. You'll see bucks from 18-30" on this hunt. Awesome juniors hunt. Our hunts are for five days, we recommend the last five days of the hunt for maximum opportunity, but you can pick the days you want.

2nd choice: Hunt # 1151, Unit 18B, Nov. 20 -29 2009 75 tags \$1,500

This is a rifle hunt, but will require a lot of work to get a good one. We hunt for five days, you pick 'em!

JUNIORS-ONLY JAVELINA HUNTS: Only juniors who have not already taken a pig in '09 can apply.

1st choice hunt 5503 Unit 18B 75 tags \$1,000 5 day fully guided and outfitted hunt 100% success in the past in this unit.

2nd choice hunt 5501 Unit 16A 50 tags. \$1,000 5 day fully guided and outfitted hunt 80% success in the past in this unit.

Desert Bighorn Sheep: 1st choice: hunt # 6011 Unit 15D Dec.1 -31 2009 \$5,000 6 tags this year. Lots of older class rams here. In '08 our hunter took a ram that sported a 35 inch horn on the 19th day of his hunt! Best chance for a NR who wants a great desert ram. NOTE: We book this hunt for the full 31 days to ensure you get a great ram.

2nd choice: hunt # 6008 Unit 15B West Dec. 1-31 2009 3 tags \$5,000

Some good rams here, we'll be hunting for one 150 or better. You're booked for the entire month so you'll have the best chance to bag a once-in-a-lifetime trophy!

Rocky Mountain Sheep: 1st choice: hunt #6055 Foote Creek in Unit 27 Dec.1-31 2009

\$6,000 Good area and there are three tags available, so NR's do have a chance to draw.

2nd choice: hunt # 6053 Unit 27 South Dec. 1-15-2009 \$6,000 Tough draw, three tags available, so NR's do have a chance to draw.
